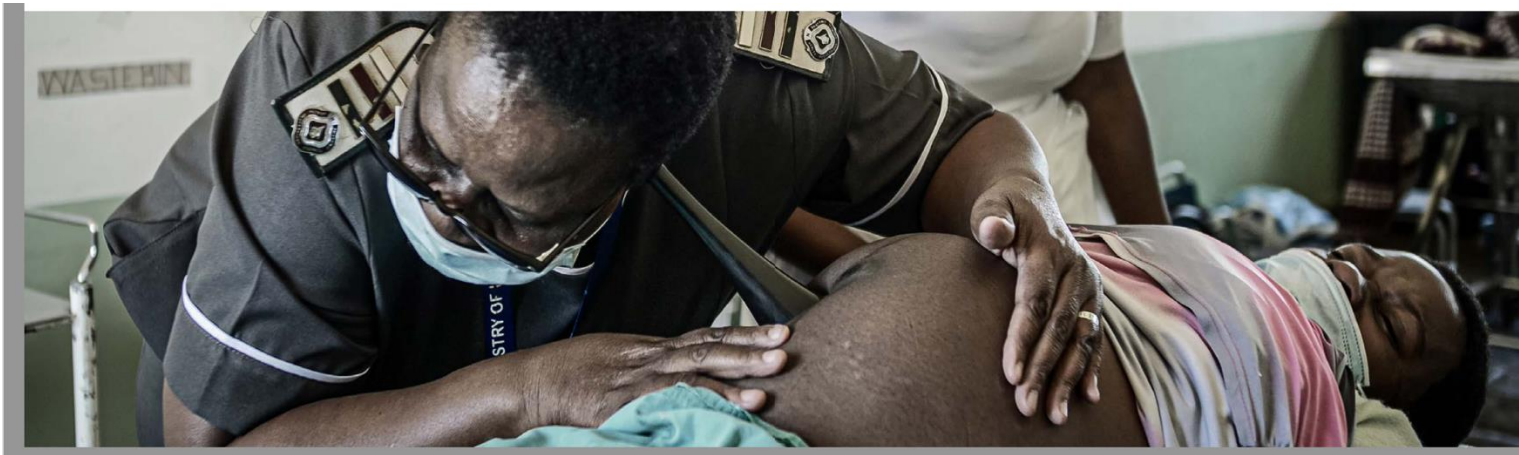

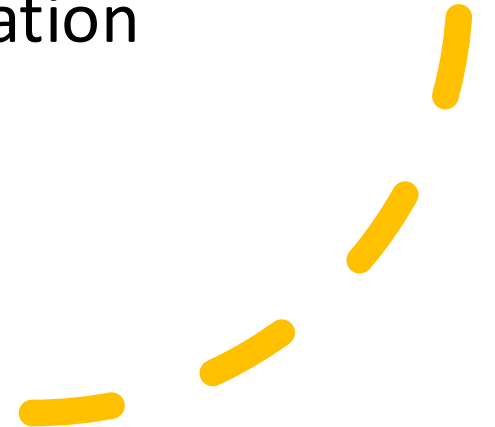

- Emergency response and decisions

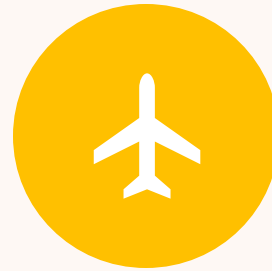

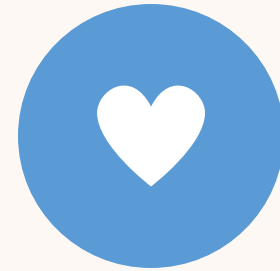

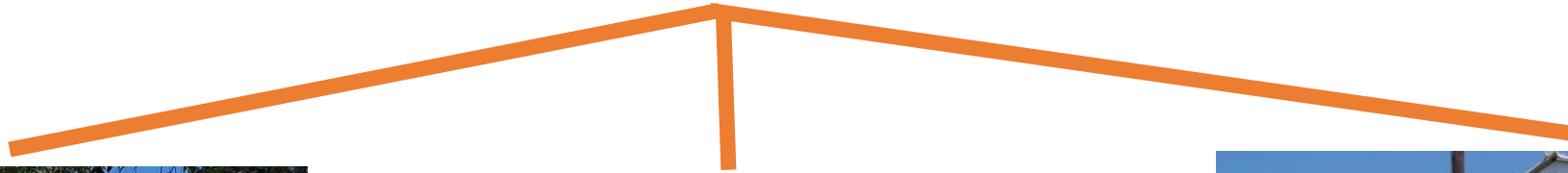

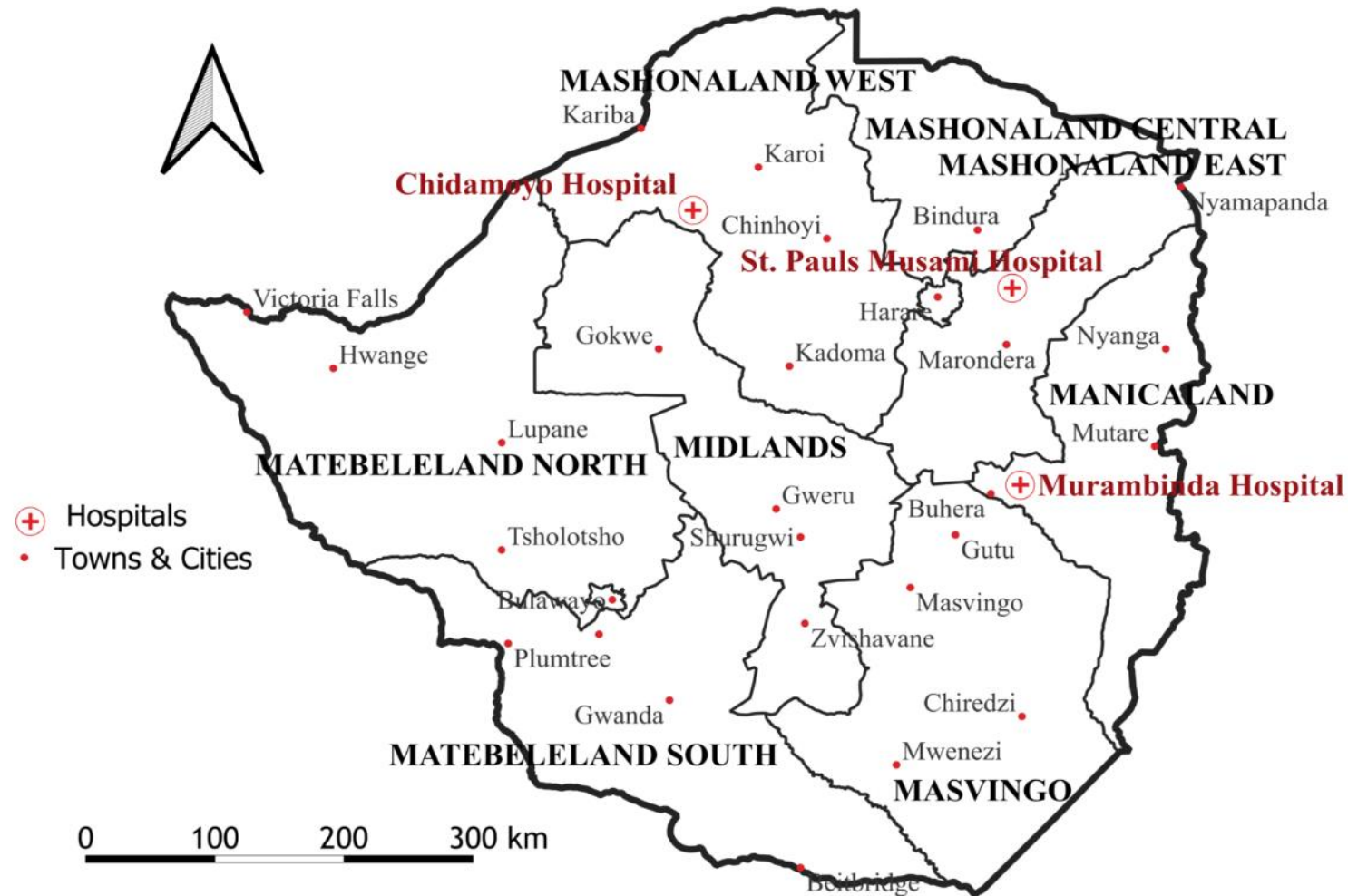

# Key Metrics: Measuring Our Outcomes

What will change after we do the work



## CONNECT

- Reliable telemedicine network established
- Number of telemedicine consultations



## TRAIN

- Number of health workers trained
- Number of educational sessions



## IMPROVE

- Decrease in transfers
- Decrease in referrals

# Key Metrics: Long-Term Impact Examples

How is life better in the long run

- **Antenatal care (ANC):** Increase >4 ANC visits
- **Intrapartum Care:** Reduced cesarian sections
- **Maternal Health:** Decrease maternal mortality
- **Perinatal Health:** Decrease perinatal mortality

# Budget and Funding Plan

- Santa Rosa Rotary and Partners: \$46,154
- District Designated Funds: \$57,692
- Rotary Foundation World Fund: \$46,154

# Program Cost Breakdown

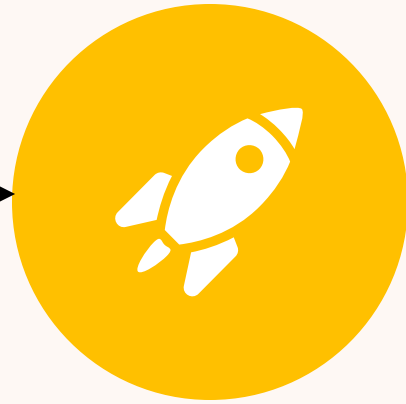
